TYPE	DESCRIPTION	HOMESCHOOLING STATUS
Public ISD (Including homebound education, and online courses, e.g. University Prep)	Educational program dictated by the local ISD, under the State direction and oversight of the UIL	Ineligible
Local Charter School	Educational program dictated by local Charter School, undertake direction of the Charter School Board and oversight of the UIL.	Ineligible
Community College (Including Dual Credit Hours)	Educational program dictated by Community College (e.g. South Plains) under direction and oversight of the State.	Use 51% Rule
Private School (e.g. Southcrest Christian, Trinity, All Saints, etc.)	Educational program dictated by School under the direction and oversight of TAPPS, SPC, etc)	Use 51% Rule Disallow full-time* students
University Model School (e.g. Kingdom Preparatory Academy)	Educational program dictated by School, under the direction and oversight of TAPPS or other extracurricular organization.	Use 51% Rule Disallow full-time* students
Distance Learning Program (e.g. Bob Jones, Abeka, Texas Tech High School, k12.com , etc.)	Educational program dictated by non-local Sponsor and classes monitored by Parent at home	Eligible
Hired Instructor or Tutor (at home or another location)	Educational program dictated by Parent and classes sometimes monitored by Parent at home	Eligible
Enrichment Coops	Educational program dictated by Parent	Eligible
Contracted Services/Course-Level Coops	Educational program dictated by Parent and conducted by “hired” teachers under the direction of the Parent	Eligible
Parent-Taught Classes (may include CD’s, online, video school, etc.)	Educational program directed wholly by the Parent using purchased or developed curriculums	Eligible

*Full-Time is defined as 4 or more courses taken at a private or university model school.

Note: If a student is attending “part-time” at a TAPPS, SPC, or UIL school, and that school deems the student eligible to participate in its sports program(s), then that student is ineligible for the LHCAA sports programs.
